

DAN AIR is set to fly from Bacău to three new destinations - Madrid, Bologna, and Milan (Bergamo), starting from March 31

The weekly frequency of DAN AIR flights will also increase on all routes included in the summer schedule

DAN AIR, the 100% Romanian airline, announces its summer flight schedule from "George Enescu" International Airport in Bacău. From March 31 to October 26, DAN AIR extends the list of destinations for regular flights, adding cities such as Madrid, Bologna, and Milan (Bergamo). Thus, DAN AIR will operate flights to 11 top destinations in Europe during the summer season. The new summer program also brings increased weekly frequencies for all routes.

DAN AIR officially began operations at "George Enescu" International Airport in Bacău on December 11, 2023. **89% of flights were operated on time, while 11% experienced delays of up to three hours**, primarily due to unfavorable weather conditions. There were no flights with delays exceeding 3 hours.

DAN AIR is a 100% Romanian airline founded in 2017 by Captain pilot Dan IUHAS, then operating under the name Just Us Air. It initially conducted ACMI (Aircraft. Crew. Maintenance. Insurance) flights for various internationally renowned airlines such as Cote D'Ivoire Jazeera Airways, Transavia, TUI, Air Moldova, Air Baltic, Air Serbia, and Wizz Air. The company later rebranded to DAN AIR and began operating regular flights under its own brand. DAN AIR flew to major destinations in Europe from airports in Bucharest and Braşov and now exclusively operates regular flights from "George Enescu" International Airport in Bacău.
