

DAN AIR to operate flights for Fly Baghdad, from Iraq to Europe, starting from December

The Romanian company will fly, for two years, from Baghdad and Erbil to Dusseldorf, Berlin and Copenhagen

The 100% Romanian airline, DAN AIR, will start operating flights for Fly Baghdad in Iraq. The first flight is scheduled for December 23, on the Baghdad-Berlin route. The Iraqi airline has leased a DAN AIR aircraft under an ACMI (Aircraft, Crew, Maintenance, and Insurance) partnership. The partnership was established as Fly Baghdad is prohibited from flying in Europe. DAN AIR will operate flights from Iraq to Europe for a period of two years.

December schedule

DAN AIR will fly, based on the ACMI partnership, from Baghdad and Erbil to Berlin, Dusseldorf, and Copenhagen. The December schedule is as follows:

- December 24: Berlin-Erbil
- December 24: Erbil-Dusseldorf
- December 25: Dusseldorf-Erbil
- December 26: Erbil-Berlin
- December 27: Berlin-Baghdad
- December 27: Baghdad-Dusseldorf
- December 27: Dusseldorf-Erbil
- December 28: Erbil-Copenhagen
- December 28: Copenhagen-Erbil
- December 29: Erbil-Dusseldorf
- December 30: Dusseldorf-Baghdad

DAN AIR is a 100% Romanian airline founded in 2017 by Captain pilot Dan IUHAS. The company was originally named Just Us Air. The company has previously operated ACMI flights (Aircraft, Crew, Maintenance, Insurance) for various internationally renowned airlines such as *Jazeera Airways, Transavia, TUI, Air Moldova, Air Baltic, Air Serbia, and Wizz Air*. The company changed its name to DAN AIR and began operating regular flights under its own brand. DAN AIR flew to important destinations in Europe from Bucharest and Brasov

and now operates regular flights exclusively from George Enescu International Airport in Bacău.
