

DAN AIR is involved in transporting passengers from Tel Aviv to Romania The Romanian airline operates flights at the request of a travel agency from Israel

Requests for flights from Tel Aviv to Romania have been increasing in the context of the military conflict in Israel. The Romanian airline DAN AIR has received several requests in the recent days for the transportation of foreign or Romanian passengers from Tel Aviv to various cities in Romania. The requests have come from a travel agency that has pilgrims or tourists in Israel, or from individuals who want to leave the conflict zone.

DAN AIR has already operated two flights from Bucharest to Tel Aviv and plans to operate a series of charter flights for their partner in Israel in the following days.

"We promptly responded to the requests from the travel agency in Israel, given the dramatic situation that those in the midst of the military conflict are going through. We were required to manage this crisis immediately, reorganize our crew schedules, and ensure that we bring passengers to their destination as quickly as possible. It is important to know that aspects related to booking tickets for these flights and organizing passengers are exclusively handled by the travel agency that requested these flights. Therefore, the ticket prices are not set by our company- DAN AIR," stated Matt Ian DAVID, CEO of DAN AIR.

The company has also flights scheduled to this destination from other airports in the country.

DAN AIR is a Romanian airline, founded in 2017 by Captain Dan luhas, under the name Just Us Air. It used to operate only ACMI (Aircraft, Crew, Maintenance, and Insurance) flights for various internationally acknowledged airlines.
